




1. Creation

1665

King Louis XIV creates the Manufacture royale des glaces under the impetus of his Minister Colbert

 Aim: Compete against Venetian supremacy in mirror glass manufacturing



BEGINNINGS

 The Manufacture royale des glaces founds its reputation on large royal orders

Manufacture of the mirrors for the Hall of Mirrors in the Palace of Versailles

Operations begin in the village of Saint-Gobain, in northern France

The innovation of **glass table pouring** made it possible to produce larger pieces more quickly than with the blown glass technique

Materials for **public buildings** with the development of architecture using iron and glass


2. INTERNATIONALIZATION
