

THE FOREST OF ILLUSIONS (GUYANA) BY GRÉGORY ALEXANDER




The child went into the forest to find his grandmother, who had disappeared. To fight whoever did this. Even if his name is Massala and he is nothing less than the guardian of the great woods. Not just any wood. This forest, where the border between reality and dream is porous. Confused. Like that mist that rises in the distance. On his way, the child meets a white caiman. A caïman like that is rare. There are no books about it in school. The beast thinks he is "built" like that, because of the humans pouring things into the river and that's why he has some rabies. But deep down, he doesn't really know. Moreover, he prefers to "wait and see" before devouring the child...

THE CUEILLEURS DE BRUME COMPANY

The Cueilleurs de brume company was born from a meeting between Anne Meyer and Gregory Alexander,

artists and technicians identified in the landscape of contemporary Guyanese creation. After a previous collaboration, the observation of a shared artistic sensitivity naturally pushed the two artists to extend this project dynamic through that of the Cueilleurs. The company, which has been in existence since August 2014, inherits nearly 20 years of accumulated experience from the two founding artists. Since its inception, the Cueilleurs have included their work in a dynamic of questioning the relationship that our societies have with the right to be different. The Gatherers are also interested in the place given to minorities and the place given to youth in social projects. Les Cueilleurs notably participated in the creation of the show "Les particules du Genre humain" in 2017, which featured 10 actors with Down's Syndrome 21. In 2016, the company developed the cultural action "Territoires en scènes" which aims to question the Amerindian malaise of Teko and Wayampi through the creation of the text "The revenants" by Grégory Alexander.



THE KING KONG THEORY (BELGIQUE) BY VIRGINIE DESPENTES

A two voices reading of King Kong Theory by Virginie Despentes with a Korean actress and Selma Alaoui, a French-Belgian actress and director, this show would be the first step in a collaboration between Liège's Theater and the South Korean National Theater Company, which should lead to the production of crossover shows with mixed teams. In this essay, where life and reflection are intertwined, Virginie Despentes returns to the issues inherent in her works and her literary trajectory. The text questions in a frontal way the female sexuality and the original definition of the female. Presented by her publisher as "a manifesto for a new feminism", King Kong Theory, in his own way, sketches both an observation of the feminine in the present and attempts to open up the field of possible futures.

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THE BATH (FRANCE) BY JEAN-LUC LAGARCE

The Bath is a moment of well-being, a love story, a reunion where the protagonists loved each other; a moment of immense happiness where everything seems to happen at the same time. The one who tells the story, finds G. dying, for a weekend in Paris and before returning to Berlin. There, they go to the cinema, to the restaurant, have sex and take a bath; and as soon as the weekend is over, he realized that this bath was the greatest happiness he had been given with the despair of impending death and the separation, still to come.

The words of the one who tells, transport towards the memory; suddenly reappears

what has been lost with the physical feeling of what it was. The word becomes a wandering between what was and what is, between before and today, between extreme happiness and its memory. It was this idea of wandering that had to be transcribed.


THE SIMPLE INSTANT COMPANY

In April 2015, the SIMPLE INSTANT company created its first show: Hamlet-machine by playwright and poet Heiner Müller. Since then, it has carried out a series of actions in the region: Fables de Lafontaine in retirement homes, workshops in Saint-Flour for children, adolescents and adults, amateur workshops in Bourg-Lastic. Since 2016, a small form has been given, both in apartments and theatres: Jean-Luc Lagarce's apprenticeship. In May and June 2017, is given at the Cours des 3 Coquins and at the Espace Nelson Mandela, *Gaspard* by Peter Handke. George Dandin by Molière in October 2017 in Bourg-Lastic. *The Bath* is the latest creation and will be performed in January 2018 at La Cour des 3 Coquins.

LORÀNT DEUTSCH

French actor/director and author, Lorànt Deutsch oscillates between comedy, theatre and historical film. Having become a must, he plays Jean-Paul Sartre or Nicolas Fouquet for television, Mozart or Oscar Wilde in the theatre, Jean de la Fontaine and many roles in comedies for the cinema.

"Metronome", his first book on the history of Paris, was a huge success with more than 2 million copies sold and adapted for television.

His second book "Hexagone", a 2600-year journey through the history of France, already sold more than 300,000 copies, has also been published for television.

Sparkling, funny, sensitive and adventurous, he now offers us a great journey to the heart of the French language.



JUST THE END OF THE WORLD (KOREA) BY JEAN-LUC LAGARCE

Louis is visiting his family for the first time in years. He finds his mother, his sister Suzanne, his brother Antoine and his sister-in-law Catherine. He intends to tell them about his illness and his impending death is irremediable, but his arrival brings back memories and family tensions. Each one expresses various reproaches and Louis leaves without having been able to make the announcement of his death.



THÉÂTRE FRANCOPHONIES

After having pursued a work of co-translation

of Korean theatre texts into French (Prize for Theatre Translation for a collection of Korean plays in French entitled "Korean Theatres" at Harmattan's since 1998), Cathy Rapin, director, and Hye-gyong Im, translator, playwright and theatre critic, began staging professional performances in 2001 with a first play as part of the festival for young women directors with The dying king of Ionesco.

Then, in 2009, they founded their company, Théâtre Francophonies, with the desire to bring together Francophones and non-French speakers around the contemporary theatre of the Francophonies, for which they had participated in the group reading and staging of the world's theatres for ten years in Seoul.

Over the years, Théâtre Francophonies has produced annually, demanding French-language plays in Korean with freelance actors or actors from different troupes who form an ephemeral "family" that is constantly being recomposed.

Denis Sungho made his 2005 Carnegie Hall debut in New York as a "Rising Star" of the European Concert Hall Organization (ECHO). Since winning first prize at the age of 14 in Belgium's national "Young Talent" competition, Denis Sung-ho has appeared on the main stages of the world, including Concertgebouw in Amsterdam, Musikvereinin Vienna, Mozarteumin Salzburg, Symphony Hall in Birmingham, Konserthuset in Stockholm, Megaron in Athenes, Palais des Beaux Arts in Brussels, Cite de la Musique in Paris, and the Cologne Philharmonie, Berlin Philharmonie... He has appeared in festivals such as the MusikTriennale in Koeln, and with ensembles such as Ensemble Intercontemporain and Oxalys. French, Belgian, Canadian, US radio, as well as South Korean television and print media, have covered his international career.




He is a music laureate of the "Fondation Belge de la vocation".

DREAM ART CENTER / HALL 1

Located in the northeast of the city centre, in the heart of the Daehakro theatre district, near exit 1 of Hyewha station, the DREAM ART CENTER is a complex of 4 modern, comfortable and well equipped theatres. The main hall or hall 1 is divided into two floors, which has 350 seats (200 on the ground floor, 150 on the balcony). The stage, 8m x 11m wide, has recent and complete sound and light equipment. In addition, the theatre has a large and warm lobby, which can also be used as a reception room.





