- This Request for Bids follows the General Procurement Notice for this Project that appeared in Development Business of 4th December 2015.
- 2. The Government of Mozambique has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of Water Services and Institutional Support Project II (WASIS II) and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for Expansion of the Wellfields, Rehabilitation and Expansion of the Water Treatment Plant and Pumping Station, Tete and Moatize.
- 3. Fundo de Investimento e Património do Abastecimento de Água (FIPAG) as implementing agency, now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for Expansion of the Wellfields, Rehabilitation and Expansion of the Water Treatment Plant and Pumping Station, Tete and Moatize. The construction period is 18 months. The major works under this Contract comprise but are not limited to the following:
 - Supply and installation of electromechanical equipment of 60 new and existing boreholes located in the Nhartanda, Canongola, Revubue I & II wellfields;
 - Construction of the Revubue II suction reservoir (500 m3) and pump station (1090 m3/h) pumping to the Cruzeiro and Matema Distribution Centres;
 - Upgrading of the of Tete water treatment plant from 12 000 m³/d to 30 000 m³/d;
 - The implementation of a supervisory control and data acquisition (SCADA) system to operate and monitor the Tete and Moatize bulk water systems.
- 4. Qualifications requirements include: the minimum average annual construction turnover within the last 5 years shall be USD 15,000,000.00. Experience under construction contracts in the role of prime contractor, JV member, Subcontractor, or management contractor for at least the last 7 years, prior to the applications sub-mission deadline. Participation as a prime contractor, joint venture member, management contractor or sub-contractor, in at least 2 similar contracts within the last 7 years, each with a value of at least USD 12,000,000.00 or one similar contract of minimum value of USD 25,000,000.00. Construction contracts for a complete Water and/or Wastewater Treatment Plant with capacity of at least 15,000 m³/d. WTP Contracts experience should include design, supply, delivery, installation and commissioning of mechanical and electrical equipment.

- 5. Bidding will be conducted through international competitive procurement using "Request for Bids (RFB)" as specified in the World Bank's Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers-Procurement in Investment Projects Financing of November 2020 and is open to all eligible Bidders as defined in the Procurement Regulations.
- Interested eligible Bidders may obtain further information and inspect the Bidding document during office hours, from 8:30h to 15:00h at the address given below.
- 7. The Bidding document in English may be purchased by interested eligible Bidders upon the submission of a written application to the address below and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of USD300.00 (three hundred US dollars) or the equivalent in Metical. The method of payment will be direct deposit into one of the two FIPAG bank accounts: Millennium BIM, MZM account no. 8992580, NIB 000 100 000 000 899 258 057, Millennium BIM Swift Code BI-MOMZMXXXX or Banco ABC USD accounts no. 100108022028, NIB 001 300 010 010 802 202 829, Banco ABC Swift Code FMBZMZMX. When requested, FIPAG will send the bidding document and the Bidder should pay for any express courier charges.
- 8. Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before 14:30h local time on September 29th 2022. Electronic Bidding will be permitted as detailed in the bidding documents. Late Bids will be rejected. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend at the address below on September 29th 2022 at 14:30h.
- Each bid must be accompanied by a bid security of USD 150,000.00 (one hundred and fifty thousand united states dollars) or an equivalent amount in a freely convertible currency.
- Pre-bid meeting and site visit will take place on 30th August 2022, at 9:30h am at FIPAG Office, Baobab-Ceta Section, Matema DC. Chingodzi Neighborhood, Tete.
