Italian Prime Minister Decree of 10 April 2020

"New" rules for productive industrial and commercial activities

The Italian Prime Minister signed the 10 April 2020 Decree¹ (the "New Italian Prime Minister Decree") providing "Additional rules implementing Decree-Law no. 19 of 25 March 2020 containing urgent measures to deal with the COVID-19 emergency, applicable on the entire national territory.

The New Italian Prime Minister Decree, which entered into force on 14 April 2020, has extended the containment measures to 3 May 2020 and regulates the safe conduct of productive industrial and commercial activities.

The New Italian Prime Minister Decree has rearranged the rules so far adopted on the matter. Therefore, at the date of its enactment (14 April 2020), the following decrees have ceased to be in force:

- The 8 March 2020 Italian Prime Minister Decree;
- The 9 March 2020 Italian Prime Minister Decree;
- The 11 March 2020 Italian Prime Minister Decree;
- ◆ The 22 March 2020 Italian Prime Minister Decree;
- ◆ The 1 April 2020 Italian Prime Minister Decree.

(article 8 of the New Italian Prime Minister Decree)

Article 8 also provides that the more restrictive measures enforced by the Regional Governments – with the Ministry of Health's agreement – in their respective territory shall continue to apply.

Article 2 of the New Italian Prime Minister Decree provides that all productive industrial and commercial activities, except those listed in Annex 3 thereof, shall be suspended (see attached list – the few additions compared to the earlier list have been marked in boldface).

The list of the codes under Annex 3 of the decree may be amended by decree of the Ministry for Economic Developments after hearing the Ministry of Economy and Finance².

The New Italian Prime Minister Decree has confirmed that the following activities and services may continue to be provided (subject to notifying the *Prefetto* – chief of police):

- public utility and essential services;
- activities of the aerospace and defense industry, including the processes, equipment, materials, services and basic infrastructure essential for national security and public rescue services;
- activities necessary to ensure the continued performance of the activities under annex 3,
 of the aerospace, defense and other activities playing a strategic role in national economy which have been authorized to continue and of the public utility and essential services;
- the manufacture, transportation, sale and delivery of pharmaceutical drugs, healthcare technology and medical/surgical equipment, as well as of agricultural and food products;
- continuous production activities, which if interrupted could cause severe damage to the equipment or risk of accidents³.

Businesses whose activities have not been suspended will have to comply with the rules of the protocol signed on 14 March 2020 between the Government and the social partners (see our earlier messages).

The New Italian Prime Minister Decree has confirmed that productive activities carried out remotely or in smart working mode may continue.

² If the list of suspended activities were amended by a Decree of the Ministry for Economic Development, companies will have 3 days from the date of the enactment of the amending decree to complete the activities required for suspension, including the dispatch of goods in storage (article 2, comma 10 of the New Italian Prime Minister Decree).

³ Notifying the *Prefetto* will not be necessary if the equipment is intended to supply an essential public service.

NEW:

The New Italian Prime Minister Decree provides that the following actions are allowed for businesses whose activities have been suspended, after notifying the *Prefetto* (chief of police):

- employees or authorized third parties in charge of security, conservation, maintenance, payment management, cleaning and sanitization activities may enter company premises;
- goods in storage may be dispatched to third parties, and goods and supplies originating from third parties may be received into storage.

The allowed activities shall be identified on the basis of the ATECO Codes recorded in the Companies Registry or, for unregistered entities, in the Revenue Agency's central tax record (anagrafe tributaria) as the taxpayer's primary, core or secondary activity.
