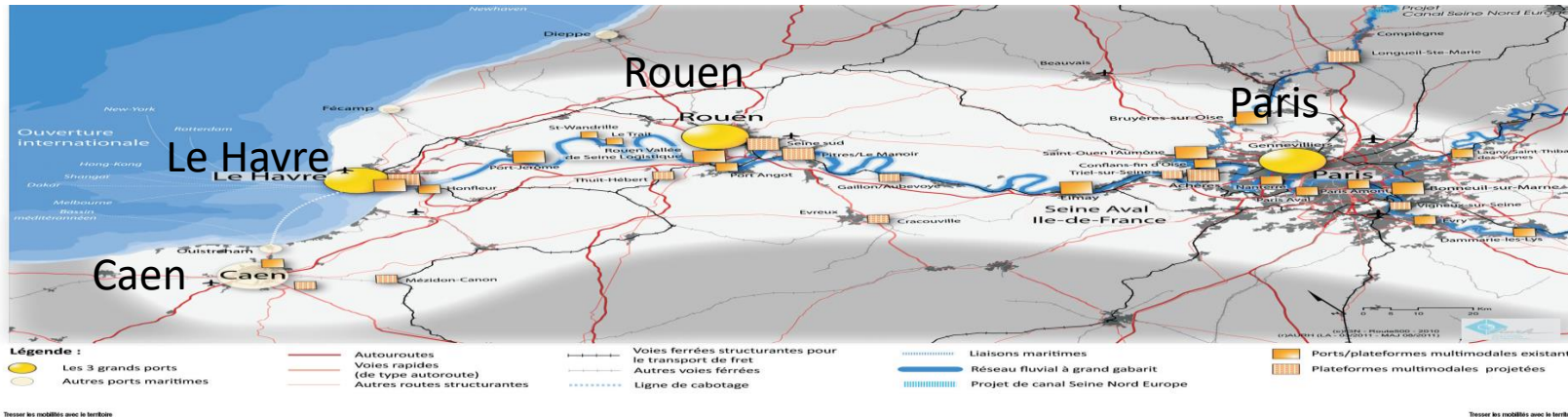

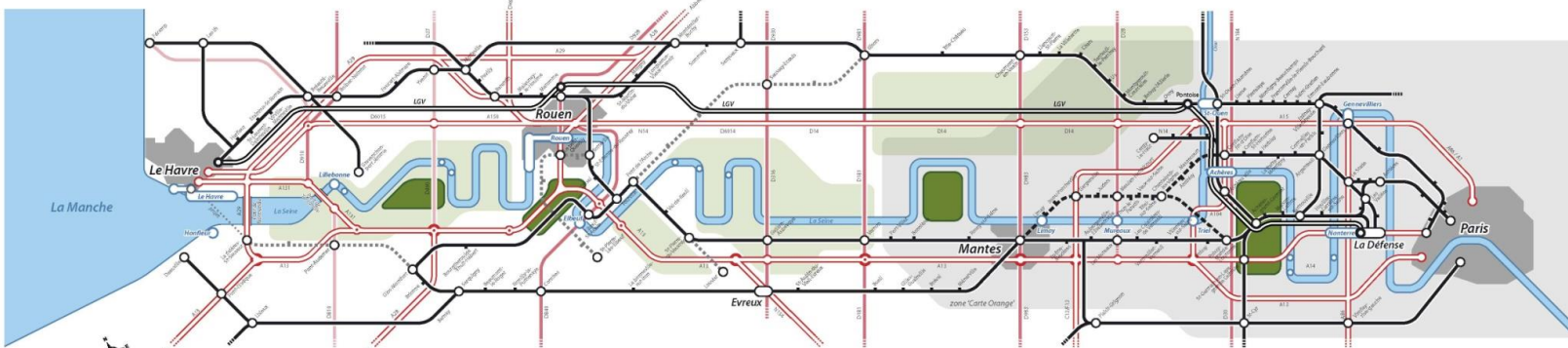
Seine Valley and HAROPA Ports
