# New formalities for crossing the border



## If you are transporting goods either for export, import, or transit

Make sure you carry your International Consignment Note (CMR), your driving license, the vehicle documents, as well as the Master Reference Number (MRN) (document with barcodes originating from a customs declaration)

## If you are transporting sanitary or phytosanitary (SPS) goods

You will be subject to a documentary check and possibly a physical check of the goods you are transporting

## If you are transporting fishery products

Make sure you carry with you a specific authorisation. You can also be subject to a customs check.



## If your HGV is empty

You will only need your driving licence as well as the vehicle documents



**I**n case of a withdrawal of the United Kingdom from the EU without an agreement ("no deal" scenario), procedures required to cross the border would be affected with new customs formalities and checks to

be carried out. Therefore, you need to make sure that your employer has prepared all necessary documents before starting your journey in order to avoid delays at the border – whether for import, export or transit.
