REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI)



CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTOR FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF HYDRAULIC PANELS AT TEMANE WELLS

Sasol Petroleum Temane Limitada (hereinafter referred to as Sasol) owns the Petroleum Production Agreement (PPA) Unincorporated Joint Venture (UJV) in Mozambique. Under the PPA, Sasol operates facilities in Mozambique, including a gas processing facility at Temane, in southern Mozambique, namely the Temane Central Processing Facility (CPF) and several wells located in Temane and Pande fields.

The PPA Wells Emergency Shutdown System (ESD) at the wellheads is controlled by the Hydraulic Control Unit (HCU). The HCU makes use of hydraulic fluid to control the opening and shut-in of the sub-surface valves (SCSSV and SSV). To keep the sub-surface valves open for continuous gas production the hydraulic system pressure is required to be above a setpoint pressure and maintained.

The PPA Temane Wells are one of the first wells to be developed as part of the PPA wells development. The existing design of the HCU is based on the earlier technology, which is purely mechanical without any electrical interface, hence for startup and maintaining of the HCU system pressure manual operation is required.

The scope of the project covers the replacement of the existing Temane HCU panels with electro-hydraulic panels at the well sites this includes the installation of cables and cable racks, instrument tubing, panel stands and consumables. The contractor should note that the HCU panels together with its junction boxes shall be supplied by SPT for installation by the contractor.

For the purpose mentioned above, interested contractors will need to prove their appropriate ability and experience to supply and install the required equipment in compliance with the technical requirements, standards and codes applicable to the Oil and Gas, whilst complying to local content requirements of the Republic of Mozambique.

This EOI is intended to solicit information required to enable Sasol to identify and assess suitably qualified and experienced Construction Contractors, preferably registered or established and operating in the Republic of Mozambique, to create an opportunity for such Contractors to potentially participate in the bidding for this project.

Sasol hereby invites eligible contractors to indicate their interest to bid for the Construction Services. Interested Construction Contractors should provide appropriate information showing that they have the required qualification(s), ability and relevant experience to perform the identified Work.

The following essential documentation and information is, therefore, required:

- Provide accredited quality, health, safety and environmental management systems as well as all applicable accreditations (Must-have)
- Provide track record of safely executed projects in the oil and gas industry and power generation industry, specifically to E&I work. (Must-have)
- Provide a procurement strategy management plan. (Must-have)
- 4. Provide company profile and relevant experience. (Must-have)
- Demonstrate the Contractor's ability to conduct business in English language.

- Provide equivalent proof of compliance to the following legal requirements (Must-have):
 - a. Applicable Mozambican legislation
- South African Legislation (Occupational Health and Safety Act, Act Number 85 of 1993 as amended), assuming responsibility to site in terms of this, including all required legal appointments.
- South African Electrical Standards e.g. SANS10142; including but not limited to special requirements for electrical certification of compliance (COC).
- 7. Project Management Services:
 - a. Provide a list of recognized management systems that would be used to manage all aspects of Project Management functions, Construction Management, Planning and Scheduling, Cost Control, Quality Assurance and Quality Control.
- b. Prove capabilities to produce project schedule and reporting.

Potential bidders will be selected in terms of Sasol's evaluation criteria (as determined by Sasol), taking into account the details that the Construction Contractor supplies, and all other information (including all risks associated with this project). Potential bidders will be selected by Sasol at its sole and unfettered discretion.
