

Sasol Petroleum Temane Limitada (“Sasol”) invites interested Surface Slickline Service Providers (the “Participant” or “Participants”) to provide a response to this pre-qualification process. Participants must be registered in Mozambique and have a proven ownership structure where all or a portion of equity is owned by Mozambique nationals. The more Mozambique national equity the higher will be the evaluating score for such Participants. A wholly owned foreign registered Participant shall not be considered.

In order to be considered as a qualified supplier for Surface Slickline Services, Participants must submit the following: ownership structure (highlighting Mozambique national ownership); company registration certificate; commercial license(s); IVA/VAT/sales tax number; audited financial reports for the last two (2) years; contact details of at least three (3) clients and what services the Participant provided to such clients (such clients may be contacted by Sasol to provide references), evidence of the number of years operating in Mozambique and documented evidence of the Participant’s SHE and Maintenance Management Systems and processes.

Additionally, Participants must respond to the following questions numbered 1 to 7, with evidence provided where applicable, using the format of the section numbers set out below:

1. Evidence and CVs of personnel which shall relate to Slickline Intervention operations: (i) Supervisors with at least 10 years experience and having IWCF level-4 Well Control certification (Well Intervention Pressure Control Program, including the wireline element) from IWCF; (ii) Operators with at least 5 years experience and holding IWCF Level-2 Certification (Well Intervention Pressure Control Program, including the wireline element) from IWCF; (iii) Sampling Specialist with at least 3 years experience; (iv) Supervisors and Operators each having at least 2 years experience in Sub-Sahara Africa; and (iv) each with experience of understanding perforating, zone change by shifting sliding sleeves, plug setting, setting of memory

gauges, memory PLT, bottomhole sampling, calliper services, downhole camera, leak detection behind casing, corrosion logging, heavy braided fishing.

2. Supply and management of a truck mounted, self-contained slickline / braided line unit (all equipment to be less than 5 years from date of manufacture) and any associated surface equipment complete with: (i) power pack / Integral crane / compressor / fluid tank(s) / pressure test pump; (ii) Inclusive of 3”, 4” & 7” Pressure control equipment including their respective BOP’s and all ancillary equipment required to connect with the clients production wells; and (iii) all required sizes of crossovers, valves and specialised connections – all which are necessary to run third party downhole tools into a wellbore in both rig and rigless operations where a Participant shall provide evidence in the form of Certificates of Conformances (COC) and a recognised third-party witness pressure testing certification, age, repair and back-up philosophy, photographs and full maintenance history of all equipment. Certification must also include but shall not be limited to; ASME B31.3, API 16 C, NACE MR-01-75, API 6A, or any other applicable Internationally recognised standards where applicable.
3. Evidence of inspection and load test for all moveable lifting tackle in accordance with legal requirements, in particular Lifting Operations and Lifting Equipment Regulations 1998 (“LOLER”), Provision and Use of Work Equipment Regulations (“PUWER”) and lifting equipment to API RP8B, or all other such standards.
4. Evidence of ISO and API accreditation, where applicable - ISO 9001 is not mandatory and any alternative quality system / manual shall be reviewed.
5. Evidence of job pre-planning, execution, post job review and an example end of well report , and technical support.
6. Evidence of third party equipment compatibility reviews and execution.

7. Where Mozambique owned companies do not have the required experience, Sasol encourages the use of joint ventures (JV) where possible to achieve an increase in local content. In the event a JV is proposed please provide all required detail including timelines.

Sasol shall prequalify Participants on the basis that all else is equal with a reputable source that does not compromise time, quality, safety, health, environment and cost.

In the event you wish to participate in this pre-qualification process, you will need to respond by 16:00 (Mozambique time) on 25 March 2022 with answers and evidence to each of the above questions.
