The French Chamber of Great Britain launches its 2024 Franco-British Business Awards

The 25th Franco-British Business Awards will celebrate the outstanding achievements of French and British companies on both sides of the Channel.

This year's five categories reflect the priorities of the French Chamber and of its community. These awards will recognise awards that have gone above and beyond to support their **people and communities**, foster **innovation**, make progress on **climate action**, and, of course, nurture the **Franco-British relationship**.

As this year marks the 120th anniversary of the Entente Cordiale, these awards will be particularly special, commemorating a century and two decades of strong and enduring cooperation between France and Britain.

The applications will open on 22 May 2024 and close on 12 July 2024. The awards ceremony will be held on 20 November 2024 in London.
