



EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR PROVISION OF LAND TRANSPORT SERVICES

Eni Rovuma Basin B.V. (ERB), Mozambique Branch invites interested companies to submit their *Expression of Interest* to provide "Land Transport Services" to support COMPANY'S Agri-feedstock project activities in Nampula province

SCOPE OF WORK

The purpose of the Scope of Work consists in the provision of land transport services including but not limited to the provision of tanker trucks/ trucks with semi-trailer tankers (30m3), dump trucks, trucks with high sided wall semi-trailers (40ft), medium cargo trucks, etc. and any related logistics services to continuously support COMPANY operational Agri-feedstock project activities mainly in the north of Mozambique and with base on Nampula province, Mozambique including the following activities:

- Transport of Bio-oil from the Agri-Feedstock plant (Monapo) to Nacala port storage location;
- Transport of Bio-products such as vegetable cake (residues of vegetable seeds after pressing of oil) or Biochar from the Agri-feedstock plant to the appointed delivery site;
- Transport of raw material (seeds, Wastes and residues), goods, material, equipment, cargo etc. (when required by COMPANY) to/from the Agri-feedstock;
- Loading and offloading services as requested and according to the type of service;
- Payment of fees, permits and any other requirements by law for land transport for each load.

All land transport vehicles shall be provided with valid certification and all applicable licenses/permits required by the local regulation and in accordance with COMPANY standards in order to perform the requested Services.

The present Scope of Work is to support mainly the phase 1 for the Agri-feedstock plant operations in Nampula province, Mozambique, with the option to extend and cover the subsequent project needs (e.g., Manica/Beira, Gaza/Maputo, Niassa/Nampula, North Zambezia, South Cabo Delgado/Nampula etc.).

The Service is envisaged to be made available from Q4 2023 with an expected duration of 60 months and 2 optional extensions of 12 months each.

An option for expanding operations to Centre and South of Mozambique regions is also envisaged, so capabilities for those regions are to be indicated by interested companies.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

Interested companies should send their Expression of Interest, submitting the following information and documentation via the website indicated below:

I. Technical documents

- a) Alvará issued by the competent Authority which attests vendor's registration in Mozambique for the provision of Land transport services herein requested;
- b) Proven experience (minimum 3 years) in the provision of the requested services;
- c) A Company Brochure or Presentation with the Company description and the list of land transport services and capabilities;
- d) Reference letters of previous services attesting vendor's experience in the provision of the requested land transport services. ALTERNATIVELY, written self-declaration signed by top management attesting the list of companies and the period when vendor provided such services;
- e) Have operating base/branch within Nampula province;
- f) Quality Management System certifications and/or Quality Management System compliant with international Quality Standards (e.g., ISO 9001);
- g) Health, Safety and Environment Management System certifications and/or documents providing the Company compliance with international standards (e.g., ISO 14001 for Environment and ISO 45001 for occupational Health and Safety).

II. Administrative documents

- a) Scanned certified copy of the Commercial Register; name of the Legal/Legal Entity and contact person for receiving the qualification package and other relevant information from Eni Rovuma Basin B.V.;
- b) Financial and Annual Reports for the past three years including Balance Sheet, Profit and Loss and Cash Flow statement. These documents must be provided by the Company's Group (if applicable), and also by the Company registered in Mozambique that may enter as the subject of the contract;

- c) Registration of the company in Mozambique. If not duly registered, the Participant shall indicate whether it would be willing to register promptly and the estimated period for doing so;
- d) Structure of the Company or Group with the list of main shareholders and final beneficiaries (if not listed on any stock exchange);
- e) If you wish to submit your Expression of Interest as a Consortium or Joint Venture (JV), information regarding each member belonging to the Consortium or JV with the respective role/position that each member will play in the potential project. The intention to form a Consortium or JV must be supported by an Agreement or "Memorandum of Understanding" duly signed by each member of the group.

Any costs incurred by the interested Companies in preparing the Expression of Interest will be the sole responsibility of the Companies who will not have recourse in this regard to Eni Rovuma Basin.

All data and information provided under this Expression of Interest will be treated as strictly confidential and will not be disclosed or communicated to unauthorized persons or companies.
