- The Administração de Infra-estruturas de Água e Saneamento (AIAS) has received financing from the UK Foreign Commonwealth and Development Office, through the Climate Resilient Infrastructure Development Facility (CRIDF) (hereinafter called the "Funder") toward the cost of the Machipanda Border Town Water Supply and Sanitation Project and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract.
- AIAS now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the supply, construction and commissioning of water supply
  and sanitation works. The project is located at Machipanda Town, Manica Province, Mozambique (19°0'21.04"S,
  32°43'1.99"E), a few kilometers from the Zimbabwe border, and comprising:
  - (i) Equipping of two existing boreholes with solar powered submersible pumps;
  - (ii) Construction and rehabilitation of additional water storage infrastructure;
  - (iii) Construction of a hydrometric spring gauging chamber;
  - (iv) Construction of a border post ablution block and water kiosk;
  - (v) Provision of 7 no. water communal stand posts; and
  - (vi) Laying of circa 8.5 km of 90 110 mm diameter water supply pipework with connections to the local hospital, two primary schools, a secondary school and the district administrative office in Machipanda.
- Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding procedures and all procurement of goods and works shall be in accordance with predominantly Multilateral Development Banks tender rules.
- It is intended to tender the project as one single Lot.

Specific requirement: to manage in-country and potential cross-border restrictions on movement caused by the coronavirus pandemic, all bidders, both Mozambican and non-Mozambican, must comply with the prevailing laws to enter Mozambique and travel within the country for the purpose of attending a pre-bid site visit and preparing their bids. The successful bidder will also be bound to comply with the referred laws for the purposes of constructing the works.
