




- Allows room for economic growth


<u>C11 — Carbon credits</u>: The use of carbon credits must not be counted as emission reductions toward the progress of companies' near-term science-based targets. Carbon credits may only be considered to be an option for neutralizing residual emissions (see Net-Zero C30) or to finance additional climate mitigation beyond their science-based emission reduction targets (see Net-Zero R3).






