Grandpuits refinery

The CEA-List, located in the CEA-Paris-Saclay and CEA-Grenoble centers, is a CEA technological research institute dedicated to **smart digital systems**.

Its R&D programs, focused on the **Industry of the future**, artificial intelligence, digital trust and digital health, contribute to the industrial competitiveness of its partners through innovation and technology transfer.

The **900 engineer-researchers** and technicians of the CEA-List put their expertise at the service of major socio-economic issues by offering **technological innovations** with high added value, centered on people and carrying values of social and environmental responsibility.

The quality of its partnership research has earned CEA-List the “Institut Carnot” label in 2020 for the 4th consecutive time.

Commissioned in 1966, Total's Grandpuits refinery was for a long time the only refinery near Paris. In September 2020, it launched a project to convert the site to **carbon neutral proceeding Sustainable Aviation Fuel (SAF)**.

The biorefinery will **process** more than **75% of waste and residues**. A partnership announced in September 2022 with SARIA will help secure feedstock supply (used cooking oils and animal fats) eligible to produce SAF. The site will be **the first biorefinery designed to maximize SAF production**, while making a major contribution to fulfilling European and French ambitions of **decarbonizing the aviation industry**.
