

Terms and conditions of membership

1. Purpose

The purpose of the General Terms and Conditions is to define the terms and conditions for company membership of the Danish-French Chamber of Commerce (hereinafter referred to as "the Chamber"), as well as the rights and obligations arising from such membership.

2. Definition of corporate members

A "corporate or sponsor member" is any legal entity (company, organization, public institution, etc.) that has subscribed to membership of the Chamber, with the aim of participating in its network, activities and services.

3. Membership procedure

- Membership is confirmed by email to a Chamber employee or by completing the membership form on our website.
 - All requests are subject to approval by the Chamber's Board of Directors.
 - The Chamber reserves the right to refuse membership without giving reasons.

4. Duration of membership

- Membership is valid for a **calendar year**, renewable by tacit agreement. An annual invoice is issued at the beginning of the new year.
- With a special agreement of the management of the Chamber of Commerce, the membership can be a subscription for **12 months from the effective date**, renewable by tacit agreement. In this case, an annual invoice is issued on the anniversary date.

5. Membership

- The annual membership fee is set by the Annual General Meeting or the Board of Directors.
 - The fee depends on the type of the membership (sponsor or company members) and size of the company for the company members (price list available on our website).
 - All fees paid are **non-refundable**, except for obvious billing errors.
 - Failure to pay within 30 days of a reminder may result in suspension of services and subsequent deregistration.

6. Corporate and sponsor member rights

Corporate members benefit from:

- Networking with other Franco-Danish members and partners;
- Participation in our VIP dinners;
- Access to joining our various committees for specific professional topics;
- Privileged access to events and workshops organized by the Chamber;
- Visibility via the member directory;
- Visibility through communication via our website, social media and email campaigns;
- Support services for setting up or developing bilateral business;
- Preferential conditions on certain services such as payroll management, recruitment or booking meeting rooms.

Sponsor members also benefit from specific advantages negotiated with the Chamber of Commerce management, such as the possibility of chairing committees, having a seat on the Board of Directors, co-organizing events, a free page in our guide 'La France à Copenhague', etc...

7. Members' obligations

Members undertake to:

- Respect the Chamber's bylaws and rules of procedure: read the Article of the Association on our website;
- Act loyally within the network, in the spirit of Franco-Danish cooperation;
- Not to damage the image or interests of the Chamber;
- Inform the Chamber of any change of situation affecting their representation or headquarters;
- Transfer the membership fee in a timely manner;
- Respect the regulatory requirements for competition when participating in our activities.

8. Communication and personal data

- The data communicated to the Chamber is used exclusively within the framework of its missions and is never transmitted to third parties without consent.
 - The company agrees to appear in communication media (directory, website, newsletter), unless otherwise requested in writing.

9. Termination and deregistration

- Members may cancel their membership by giving written notice at least **60 days before the end of calendar year**, meaning the 31st of October at the latest. After this date the membership will be renewed automatically.
 - Special case: if the membership has been negotiated on the **12 months basis from the effective date**, the notice of the cancellation should be notified **60 days before the anniversary date of subscription**.
 - In the event of non-compliance with contractual obligations, the Chamber may deregister, after formal notice has remained unanswered.
 - In the event of deregistration, outstanding membership fees remain payable and no refund will be made.

10. Liability

The Chamber is not responsible for any decisions or actions taken by members in the course of their professional relations, including during organized events or networking.

11. Modification of general terms and conditions

The Chamber reserves the right to modify these terms and conditions at any time. The new conditions will apply to all membership renewals unless the member expressly objects.

12. Applicable law - Disputes

These terms and conditions are governed by Danish law.

In the event of a dispute, the parties shall endeavor to resolve the matter amicably.

Failing this, the dispute will be referred to the competent courts in the area of the Chamber's office.
