We are looking forward to seeing you on the 17th of May, just 45 days prior to the Grand Depart.



Venue



Ukraine

At the end of the gala, a charity auction will take place in support of a humanitarian fund dedicated helping the Ukrainian people. If you would like to support this auction and great cause, you are welcome to contact us to offer gifts or



products that we can put on auction. All gifts donated for auction will be presented in the program provided to the guests at the entrance, and also by the moderator of the charity auction during the event. All funds raised during the auction will go, in full, to a humanitarian fund managed by the National Bank of Ukraine.



To give an insight to what the world will look like after the crisis, we have asked one of the most knowledgeable Danish politicians, **Per Stig Møller**, to give his view on the prospects for democracy after the Russian invasion. Per Stig Møller is a liberal Danish politician and has a doctorate in philosophy from the university of Sorbonne. He has been leading several different ministries, most

noticeably he held the office as Minister of Foreign Affairs for nearly 10 years, from 2001 to 2010. He is also the author of multiple books on subjects such as philosophy, history and politics. He regularly features as a commentator, on both Danish and international matters, in the newspaper Berlingske Tidende.

Collection

As you arrive and enjoy a welcome drink, you are invited to see an exhibition of a dozen collectors' items from the Danish and international road cycling history. This collection represents the material worn and used by the legends of the sport such as Eddy Merckx when he was taking the world by storm at the Molteni team from 1971 to



1976. In the collection you can discover bikes and jersey used by the most famous Danish former professionals, such as Bo Hamburger (Team TVM) and Michael Sandstød (Team CSC), and not to forget Rolf Sørensen and Bjarne Riis's iconic sets of equipment from the 90's.



The collection also contains bikes and jerseys from the large foreign teams such as RaboBank, Mapei, Lampra, Casino, and Mercatone Uno from the days of the italian "pirate" Marco Pantani. All in all, this exhibition is sure to impress you all and get you in the mood for the Tour de France's start in the Danish capital - we hope you enjoy and wish you a great Grand Départ!
