- The Government of Mozambique (GoM) has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Cyclone Idai and Kenneth Emergency Recovery and Resilience Project and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for Rehabilitation of the Storm Water Drainage System in the City of Beira Phase 2. This contract will be financed by World Bank and co-financing from the Government of the Netherlands (GoN) is expected through their DRIVE program, which is administered by Invest International (II). Bidding process will be governed by the World Bank's Procurement Regulations.

The Administração de Infra-Estruturas de Água e Saneamento, Instituto Público (AIAS, IP) now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders to carry out the works for rehabilitation of the primary drainage network of the city of Beira, namely canals A1 and A3, the Estoril Retention Basin, outflow structure and outlet channel to the estuary of Rio Maria, properly equipped and ready to operate, in accordance the existing requirements of the Final Design, Technical Specifications and Tendering Specifications.
