Procure and allocate improved and local goats

- The Government of Mozambique received a funding from the International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD) to support the 1. implementation of the Inclusive Agri-Food Value Chain Development Programme (PROCAVA) and intends to apply part of the financing for the Procuring and allocating improved and local goats. The use of any IFAD financing shall be subject to IFAD's approval, pursuant to the terms and conditions of the financing agreement, as well as IFAD's rules, policies and procedures. IFAD and its officials, agents and employees shall be held harmless from and against all suits, proceedings, claims, demands, losses and liability of any kind or nature brought by any party in connection with the Inclusive Agri-Food Value Chain Development Programme (PROCAVA).
- Through PROCAVA, the Government of Mozambique supports development of five (5) value chains, namely: Horticulture, Cassava, Red 2 Meat, Legumes and Poultry, in 75 districts across the Country, targeting 180.500 households, mainly smallholder farmers and other vulnerable groups including people with disabilities, during an implementation period of ten (10) years.
- The Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development (MADER) is the Programme led agency. On behalf of MADER, the Fund for 3. Agricultural Promotion and Rural Extension (FAR, FP) ensures the overall Programme coordination through a National Programme Management Unit (NPMU) based at its headquarters in Maputo city, Southern Region Programme Management Unit (RPMU - South) based at the Provincial Delegation of FAR, FP in Gaza province and the Provincial Programme Management Unit in Niassa province based at the Provincial Delegation of FAR, FP.
- This Invitation for Bid (IFB) follows the general procurement notice that appeared on the United Nations Development Business 4. (UNDB) website on 24 July 2020 and on Jornal Notícias newspaper of 09 and 12 April 2021.
- 5. The purchaser invites eligible entities ("bidders") to submit sealed bids to the Supply and allocate improved and local goats.
- 6. For more details on these goods and related services, interested bidders can request the tender document by sending an e-mail or letter, giving full contact details of the bidder, through the address indicated in Paragraph 9.
- This IFB is open to all eligible bidders who wish to respond. Subject to the restrictions noted in the bidding document, eligible entities 7. may associate with other bidders to enhance their capacity to successfully deliver the goods and related services.
- The goods and related services, and the contract expected to be awarded, are divided into the following fifteen (15) lots: Bidders can 8. bid for one or more lots, and according to the lots bidded.
