- 1. The Government of Mozambique has received financing from the International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD) towards the cost of the Inclusive Agri-Food Value Chains Development Programme (PROCAVA) and intends to apply part of the financing for the Procure tools and Equipment for using in crop yield measurement. The use of any IFAD financing shall be subject to IFAD's approval, pursuant to the terms and conditions of the financing agreement, as well as IFAD's rules, policies and procedures. IFAD and its officials, agents and employees shall be held harmless from and against all suits, proceedings, claims, demands, losses and liability of any kind or nature brought by any party in connection with the Inclusive Agri-Food Value Chains Development Programme (PROCAVA).
- Through PROCAVA, the Government of Mozambique supports development of five (5) value chains, namely:
 Horticulture, Cassava, Red Meat, Legumes and Poultry, in 75 districts across the Country, targeting 180.500
 households, mainly smallholder farmers and other vulnerable groups including people with disabilities, during an
 implementation period of ten (10) years.
- 3. The Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development (MADER) is the Programme led agency. On behalf of MADER, the Fund for Agricultural Promotion and Rural Extension (FAR, FP) ensures the overall daily Programme management and coordination through a National Programme Management Unit (NPMU) based at its headquarters in Maputo city, Southern Region Programme Management Unit (RPMU South) based at the Provincial Delegation of FAR, FP in Gaza province and the Provincial Programme Management Unit in Niassa province.
- This IFB follows the general procurement notice that appeared on the United Nations Development Business (UNDB)
 website on 24 July 2020 and on Jornal Noticias newspaper on 9 and 12 April 2021.
- The purchaser now invites sealed bids from eligible entities ("bidders") for the Procure tools and Equipment for using in crop yield measurement.
- 6. More details on these goods and related services are provided in the schedule of requirements in this bidding
- This IFB is open to all eligible bidders who wish to respond. Subject to restrictions noted in the bidding document, eligible entities may associate with other bidders to enhance their capacity to successfully carry out the procurement.
- The goods and related services, and the contract expected to be awarded, are divided into the following lots: Single lot, composed by the following items: Tape of 100 m; Rafia bags; Manchete; Hoe; Rope of 20 m; Rope of 10 m; Calculator; Clock-like Scale with clock; Hydrostatic Scale; Moisture meter and GPS.
- Bidding will be conducted using the National Competitive Bidding (NCB) method, the evaluation procedure for
 which is described in this bidding document, in accordance with the IFAD Procurement Handbook which is provided
 at www.ifad.org/project-procurement. The NCB process, as described, will include a review and verification of
 qualifications and past performance, including a reference check, prior to the contract award.
- Please note that a pre-bid conference will not be held as described in the bid data sheet (BDS), Section III of the bidding document.
- 11. Bidders interested in submitting a bid shall purchase the bidding document against payment of a non-refundable fee of 1.500,00MT Bidding documents can be obtained by sending an e-mail or letter, giving full contact details of the bidder, to the following point of contact.
