## Acquisition and Supply of Seed-Potato

- 1. The Government of Mozambique received a financing from the International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD) to support the implementation of the Inclusive Agri-Food Value Chain Development Programme (PROCAVA) and intends to apply part of the funding for the Acquisition and Supply of Seed-Potato. The use of any IFAD financing shall be subject to IFAD's approval, pursuant to the terms and conditions of the financing agreement, as well as IFAD's rules, policies and procedures. IFAD and its officials, agents and employees shall be held harmless from and against all suits, proceedings, claims, demands, losses and liability of any kind or nature brought by any party in connection with the Inclusive Agri-Food Value Chains Development Programme (PROCAVA).
- Through PROCAVA, the Government of Mozambique supports development of five (5) value chains, namely: Horticulture, Cassava, Red Meat, Legumes and Poultry, in 75 districts across the Country, targeting 180.500 households, mainly smallholder farmers and other vulnerable groups, during an implementation period of ten (10) years.
- 3. The Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development (MADER) is the Programme Lead Agency. On behalf of MADER, the Fund for Agricultural Promotion and Rural Extension (FAR, FP), ensures the overall daily Programme management and coordination through a National Programme Management Unit (NPMU) based at its headquarters in Maputo, Southern Region Programme Management Unit (RPMU South) based at the Provincial Delegation of FAR, FP in Gaza province and the Provincial Programme Management Unit based at Provincial Delegation of FAR, FP in Niassa province.
- This Invitation for Bid (IFB) follows the general procurement notice that appeared on the United Nations Development Business (UNDB) website on 24 July 2020 and on Jornal Noticias newspaper on 9 and 12 April 2021.
- 5. The purchaser invites eligible entities ("bidders") to submit sealed bids for Acquisition and Supply of Seed-Potato.

- This IFB is open to all eligible bidders who wish to respond. Subject to the restrictions noted in the bidding document, eligible entities may associate with other bidders to enhance their capacity to successfully deliver the goods and related services.
- 8. The goods and related services, and the contract expected to be awarded, are divided into the following four (4) lots:
  - Lot 1: Procure of G2 Irish potato seed (25 kg bags)
  - Lot 2: Procure fertilizers for potato seed producers
  - Lot 3: Procure fitossanitary products for potato seed producers
  - Lot 4: Procure working tools for potato seed producers (Sprayers, PPE)
- Bidding will be conducted using the International Competitive Bidding (ICB) method, the evaluation procedure for
  which is described in this bidding document, in accordance with the IFAD procurement handbook which is provided
  on the IFAD website <a href="https://www.ifad.org/en/document-detail/asset/42187284">https://www.ifad.org/en/document-detail/asset/42187284</a>. The ICB process, as described,
  will include a review and verification of qualifications and past performance, including a reference check, prior to the
  contract award.
