Mr Andrew Tan was formerly Managing Director with Temasek International, a global investment firm headquartered in Singapore. He joined as an Operating Partner in the Enterprise Development Group, and later as Managing Director of the new Strategy Office from 2019-2022.

Prior to joining Temasek, Mr Tan spent nearly three decades with the Singapore Administrative Service in senior positions across key agencies from the Ministry of Information & the Arts, Ministry of Defence, Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Prime Minister's Office as the Principal Private Secretary to Senior Minister/Minister Mentor Lee Kuan Yew, the Ministry of Environment and Water Resources and the Ministry of Transport. He later became the Chief Executive Officer of the National Environment Agency (NEA) from 2009-2013 and Founding Director of the Centre for Liveable Cities (CLC) from 2008-2010. He was also Chief Executive of the Maritime and Port Authority of Singapore (MPA) from 2014-2018.
