Safe Child Thailand is a UK-registered charity with offices in London and Thailand. We work with local partners to protect vulnerable children nationwide. Our mission is to create a safe, equitable Thailand where every child can thrive and participate fully in society.

Action Location: Bangkok, Tak, Rayong, Chonburi, Nong Khai, Chiang Mai and Phuket

Size	Operate with a small, efficient team in the UK and Thailand. The UK office is led by the CEO with support from a fundraising team of three and a part-time finance officer, while the Thailand office has six staff members. In 2023–2024, the charity’s total income was £619,115, mainly from donations, grants, and legacies.
Beneficiary Nationality	Support Thai, migrant, and displaced families, focusing on children with disabilities, refugees, those in care, unaccompanied minors, and ethnic minorities.
Action Impact	In 2024–2025, Safe Child Thailand directly supported 3,332 children and families and reached 76,976 others indirectly. Key outcomes include: • 195 children with disabilities received home care and family support • 321 children gained access to nutritious school lunches • 434 out-of-school children re-enrolled in education • 332 youth pursued GED diplomas • 44 young adults completed vocational training for employment
Use of Donation Funds	Plan for the funding to go directly to support the work with vulnerable children and their families. Plan to allocate the funds across the programs: - 85% going towards direct services costs - 15% going towards programs management and monitoring
Long-term Vision & Alignment	Safe Child Thailand’s long-term vision is for a safe and equitable Thailand for all children, where every child in Thailand, regardless of ability, background, or circumstance, can grow, learn, and participate fully in society. Over the coming years, we seek to expand our community-based care programs, build more resilient communities, and empower local partners to create sustainable systems that safeguard children’s rights and wellbeing.
