

# Winter 2025–2026: Air France will offer a new nonstop service between Paris–Charles de Gaulle and Phuket

- Up to 3 direct flights per week starting November 27, 2025, on Boeing 777-300ER aircraft.

Air France reveals the first new addition to its winter 2025–2026 flight schedule. After launching a new route to Manila last year, the airline is once again turning its focus to Asia. Starting November 27, 2025, Air France will offer a new nonstop service between Paris–Charles de Gaulle and Phuket, in southern Thailand. Three flights per week will operate on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Saturdays on departure from Paris, with return flights from Phuket on Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Sundays. The flights will be operated on Boeing 777-300ER aircraft.

**Flight schedule (in local time):**

- AF156: departs Paris–Charles de Gaulle at 3:50pm, arrives in Phuket at 9:25am the following day;
- AF157: departs Phuket at 11:50am, arrives at Paris–Charles de Gaulle at 7:10pm.

This flight schedule is subject to obtaining the necessary government authorizations.

With this new route, Air France continues to meet the growing demand for travel to Asia. During the winter 2025–2026 season, Air France will serve 11 destinations across the region: Bangkok, Beijing, Ho Chi Minh City, Hong Kong, Manila, Osaka, Seoul, Shanghai, Singapore, Tokyo–Haneda, and now Phuket.
